

Maintenance Person

Job Summary

The maintenance person is responsible for all the required maintenance in our self-catered chalet apartments and catered chalets as required they will have to respond to requests for repairs and prioritise depending on how serious the problems are. The work can be anything from unlocking a sink/shower/dishwasher through to fixing furniture and putting back in electrical plugs that have popped out. For anything specialist then they will be responsible for co-ordinating the specialist repair people to come in and undertake the work. The location for this post will be La Plagne Montalbert although you will be working across our resorts, being able to drive is required in addition having a car at your disposal may be an advantage. We would expect that you will get between 3 -4 days skiing each week.

Skills and Experience Required

- Good communication and organisational skills and ability to prioritise your own activities
- Ability to work very hard especially at the weekend when the majority of our apartments change over
- A full clean driving licence
- Be able to bring out your own tool kit

Job Description

- At the beginning of the season check all apartments and chalets to identify any maintenance needs. Compile a list and prioritize and undertake any work required before the guests start to arrive
- On a weekly basis liaise with the resorts managers. Cleaners and chalets hosts to identify any required maintenance then prioritise the list and on weekends undertake any necessary immediate repairs, all other repairs to be undertaken during weekdays
- During times when there are no repairs to be undertaken help with chalet /apartment cleaning and any other duties that the Resort Manager/Directors may ask you to conduct.
