



# Directions – La Plagne Montalbert

## **From UK**

From Calais it's about an 8 – 9 hour drive. Follow A26 towards Reims & Troyes, and then follow A5/ A31 towards Dijon. Then A6 toward Macon and Lyon and finally A43 to Chambéry and then Albertville then pick up directions below

## **Satellite Navigation**

We suggest that you do not follow Sat Nav as this takes you via Paris which can take much longer and in addition it will try to take you over mountain passes that are closed in the winter. However if you do wish to use Sat Nav then the nearest town is Aime La Plagne which you will need to put into the Sat Nav system. The postcode of Plagne Montalbert is 73210 but beware this covers a wide area and there are no street names in the village.

## **From Geneva Airport**

There are two ways of getting to Montalbert either directly on the motorway which takes circa 2 hours or the scenic way past Annecy lake which takes circa 2.5 hours. These times do vary upon the conditions and time of year please allow more time during peak weeks and in the snow.

When collecting the car at Geneva come out of the parking and turn right. Follow the green (Motorway) signs for France and keep following the green signs (this will take you less than 2 minutes) until you get onto the motorway.

## **From Geneva using the Motorway all the way**

Follow initially the directions to Annecy/Chambéry (A41). Once at Chambéry follow the motorway signs to Albertville which is a right turn off the motorway. Pick up directions below from Albertville. NB This is a toll road

## **Via the Annecy lakeside route**

As above but come off at Annecy North turn off and follow the direction to Annecy Centre then follow the signs to “Le Lac” through Annecy until you actually get to the lake itself. Turn right following the signs to Albertville (you keep the lake on your left hand side). After circa 45 minutes you get to Albertville.

### **From Lyon Airport**

After coming out of the airport simply follow the motorway to Chambéry and onwards to Albertville

### **From Chambéry Airport**

Follow the signs to Albertville A43

### **From Grenoble Airport**

Follow the A41, and then follow the A43 to Albertville

### **From Albertville**

Take the RN90 marked Haute Tarentaise. As you approach Moutiers you need to be in the left hand lane as the road divides into three at this point, but you are still following the RN90. This should take you circa 30 minutes or less.

Follow the RN90 until you see a sign for Aime (also indicated La Plagne) turn right here and follow the road through Aime. Continue for about 1 km and you will see a large light coloured furniture shop on your right. About 100 metres after this you will see the road to Montalbert on the right. Keep following this road and you will pass through a small village called Longefoy. Keep driving uphill about another 2 kms and as you approach the entrance to Montalbert there is a severe hairpin bend.

**Les Chalets de Montalbert Apartments** - Take the road left at the hairpin bend indicated "Centre Station" and follow as far as you can. After 2 hairpins you will see the chalets on the right these are called Les Chalets de Montalbert the first one you come across is chalet C. with B in the middle and chalet A being the last one on the right up the hill

**Les Granges Apartments/Alexander Chalet**-Go round the hairpin bend signposted Montalbert 1600, take the next sharp left turn which is signposted Aguille Rouge Hotel keep going up and take first right. Les Granges is just on the left hand side with parking outside.

**La Bergerie Apartments**- Take the road left at the hairpin bend indicated "Centre Station" our La Bergerie apartments are in the chalet on the right hand side as your drive up circa 300m from the hairpin bend. They are next to the old church

**L'Arbe Apartments** - As you enter Montalbert follow the signs for Montalbert 1600 after about 1 km and you have gone around a second hairpin bend you will see 2 chalets on your left. The first is L'Arbe 2 with a Mountain Heaven Sign on the balcony. Almost opposite are some rubbish bins and just beyond this is a parking area.
