



Directions – Grimentz

From Geneva Airport

When collecting the car at Geneva come out of the underground parking. Follow the motorway signs for Lausanne, it will take you less than 2 minutes to get onto the motorway.

Follow the A1 then A9 motorways, signed Lausanne then Simplon Pass and Brig. On the way you will pass Montreux and Martigny and then Sion and finally Sierre. Come off the motorway just after the long Sierre tunnel at Jct29 which is signposted Sierre Est and the Val D'Anniviers. This will take you about 2 hours to here.

At the exit roundabout take the 2nd exit and follow the signs for the Val D'Anniviers, you will immediately see the road condition signs for Vissoie, St Luc, Zinal and Grimentz. The road to Grimentz will take you about 20 minutes and if you contact the resort staff they will update you on village road conditions.

Follow the mountain road up, please note there are many hairpin bends so be careful and ensure that you have snow chains available if required. Go all the way to Vissoie and then turn right to Grimentz (the road initially dropping). Follow the road up until you get into the village, the road then bearing left downhill before climbing again by the post office, up past the ice skating rink (which is high on your right).

For Les Vieux Chalet - Self-Catered (Except when no 7 is catered on selected weeks) the chalet is directly on your right after the ice skating rink.

The chalet is the 'uphill' left building which is Chalet A and the pedestrian entrance is around the back of the right-hand building, take the far stairs or lift to the top, third floor for number 7 and is just on your right as you come out of the lifts or up the steps. For parking there is one underground marked space and one over ground space which is not marked. Number 2 is on the ground floor and is the middle apartment and has a marked parking space underground.

For Cole Ridge Catered Chalet carry on past Les Vieux Chalet then turn first right (just before the Co-Op) go past the lift station on your left and fork left at the supermarket/off licence which is on your right and also the ESS (Swiss ski school building), then turn sharp first left (just beyond blue bottle skip). Continue uphill, under Gondola cables, passing Chez Florioz bar (on right), then keep left and continue up away from the village up to a very sharp right hand hairpin (taking care) continue uphill and then fork left uphill at the next bend/junction and follow the road up for about 250 metres and Cole Ridge is just on your right.

Please note that the road up to Cole Ridge can be covered in snow and you will often need snow chains to get up and down the hill here but this is normal in the Alps!
